Rules and Regulations

I. Name and Aims

1. Name

Chinese:第二届“中国白”国际陶瓷艺术大奖赛(2019)

Abbreviation in Chinese:大奖赛

English: The Second “Blanc de Chine” International Ceramic Art Award(2019)

Abbreviation in English: ICAA

2. The aim of “Blanc de Chine International Ceramic Art Award” (hereinafter referred to as “ICAA”) is to promote the international exchange of contemporary ceramic art, as well as the integration and innovation of ceramic and contemporary art.

2.1 Each competition will select or nominate 5 to 7 jury committee members from the Expert Committee;

2.2 A new jury member will be chosen from the Expert Committee to substitute an existing jury member in case of absence from the final selection meeting.

IV. Time and Award

1. The ICAA will be held every two years. The 2019 ICAA is the second edition to date;

2. Prize:

The First Prize (1 winner) will be awarded 50,000 euros

The Second Prize laureates (2 winners) will each be awarded 30,000 euros

The Third Prize laureates (3 winners) will each be awarded 10,000 euros

The Excellence Prize laureates (5 winners) will each be awarded 5,000 euros

V. Entry Requirements

1. All entries must be original ones, otherwise the applicant will be disqualified;
2. All entries shall not have been displayed in any exhibitions or competitions prior, and shall not have been published in any publications or media;

3. All entries must contain more than 50% of white porcelain material;
4. Interdisciplinary entries are encouraged.

VI. Application and Selection Process

1. Application Deadline (1st October 2018 – 30th April 2019)
 - 1.1 No particular age or gender restrictions;
 - 1.2 No entry fees;
 - 1.3 Each applicant may submit up to two pieces (sets) of entries (for details, please refer to the “Blanc de Chine” International Ceramic Art Award Application Form);
 - 1.4 All application materials must be submitted to icaa@blancdechine.com before 30th April 2019.
2. Selection
 - 2.1 Initial Result

The jury members will select the shortlisted entries by vote.
 - 2.2 Final Result

The shortlisted entries shall be timely delivered to the final selection location appointed by the organizer. The jury committee will select the final winning entries by vote.
3. Announcement of Result
 - 3.1 The final winner list will be announced on the official website;
 - 3.2 The final result of the 2019 “Blanc de Chine” International Ceramic Art Award will be sent to the winners by email.

VII. Award Ceremony and the Exhibition

1. The award ceremony and exhibition will be held in an internationally renowned city;
2. The First, Second and Third Prize winners will be invited to the award ceremony. Transportation and accommodation will be paid for by the organizer;

“Blanc de Chine” International Ceramic Art Award
Rules for Shortlisted Entries

1. “Blanc de Chine” International Ceramic Art Award Shortlisted Entries (hereinafter referred to as “Shortlisted Entries”)

- 1.1 Shortlisted Entries are defined as artworks that are selected by jury committee from all submitted artworks, and will enter the final award selection.
- 1.2 All application materials shall be submitted to: icaa@blancdechine.com before April 30, 2019.
- 1.3 The shortlisted entries will be announced before 20th May, 2019 and notification will be send to concerning artists through email.
- 1.4 The shortlisted entries shall be delivered to the final award selection location before June 15, 2019. In case of untimely delivery, the work will automatically be regarded as forfeited.
- 1.5 Award winning artworks will be selected from the shortlisted entries, which meet the delivery requirements.

2. Award Ceremony and the Exhibition

- 2.1 The award ceremony and exhibition will be held in Nice or Paris, France;
- 2.2 Exhibition of award winning artworks;
- 2.3 Exhibition of non-award artworks is to be selected by jury committee and curators.

3. Shipment and insurance of shortlisted entries

The round-trip shipping and insurance fee to final selection location of shortlisted entries will be taken on by the organizer.

Prize Money and Work Donation Agreement**

Given Party B is awarded “*Blanc de Chine*” International Ceramic Art Award _____ prize, Party A and Party B negotiate terms in an honest, open and equal manner and reach the following agreement.

1. Payment of the Prize

- 1.1 Within thirty (30) business days upon the signing of this Agreement, Party A shall make the payment of _____ Euros or RMB (exchange rate is set as the middle rate published by Bank of China on the day of the award ceremony) to Party B as agreed upon by both parties.
- 1.2 Party A shall withhold and pay income tax for Party B as per regulations of Tax Law of the People's Republic of China before making the prize payment (current tax rate is 20%).

2. Donated Artworks

- 2.1 Upon receiving the prize payment, Party A shall enjoy ownership of the award-winning artwork, which is deemed donated to Party A by Party B.
- 2.2 The right of authorship belongs to Party B and Party A enjoys the other copyrights.

3. Requirements for the Donated Work

- 3.1 The award-winning work donated by Party B to Party A shall be made by Party B, original and handmade, without plagiarism and has not been made public in any publications and/or media and will not infringe any third party's intellectual property rights.
- 3.2 If the above work is created / produced in cooperation with others, Party B shall present a written explanation of the co-author / producer to Party A and agree that Party A shall identify the
- 3.3 co-author / producer in the relevant information of the work according to said

explanation. If Party A suffers any losses due to Party B's violation of this Article, Party B shall be liable for compensation.

4. Obligations of Party A

4.1 Party A shall issue collection certificates to Party B.

4.2 Where the donated artwork is damaged in the course of transportation or display by Party A, Party B shall be responsible for repair and Party A shall be responsible for the expenses thereby incurred.

5. Obligations of Party B

5.1 Party B shall ensure the integrity of the donated work prior to donation. Any flaws shall be promptly repaired after confirmation with Party A.

5.2 Party B agrees that his or her portraits (including video materials that contain his or her portraits) as well as pictures and materials of his or her personal works submitted to Party A may be used in any media promotion, exhibition and display related to the ICAA and other art events.

6. Unaccomplished Matters

The parties hereto may sign a supplement agreement for matters not mentioned herein.

7. Governing Law

This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the People's Republic of China.

8. Disputes Jurisdiction

All disputes concerning the present agreement shall be dealt with by both parties first through consultation. If consultation fails, the case shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the People's Court of the place where Party A is located in the People's Republic of China.
